The story gets brutal (25:1–26)

"King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon and his entire army advanced against Jerusalem and laid siege to the city."

- The brutal facts: The city is reduced to rubble and the people are deported to Babylon
- The painful lesson: When God warns of judgment, he's not bluffing

"So Judah went into exile from its Land."



The story is not over (25:27-30)

"He spoke kindly to King Jehoiachin of Judah and set his throne above the other kings who were there in Babylon."
