

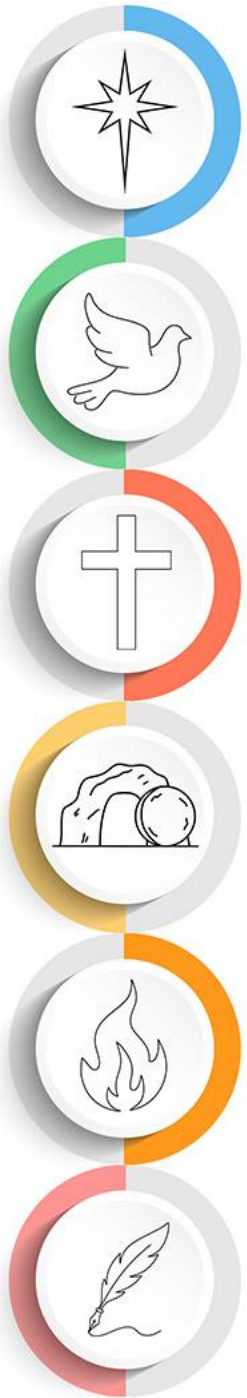

The Model Community

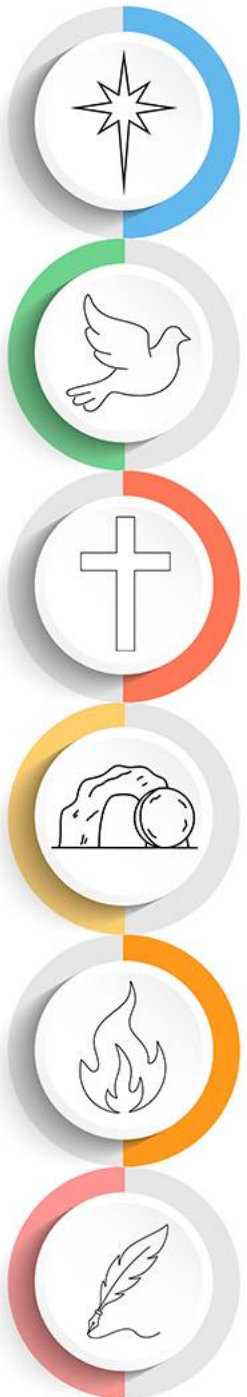
Acts 2:37–47

The ongoing pull to the New Community (Acts 2:42–47)

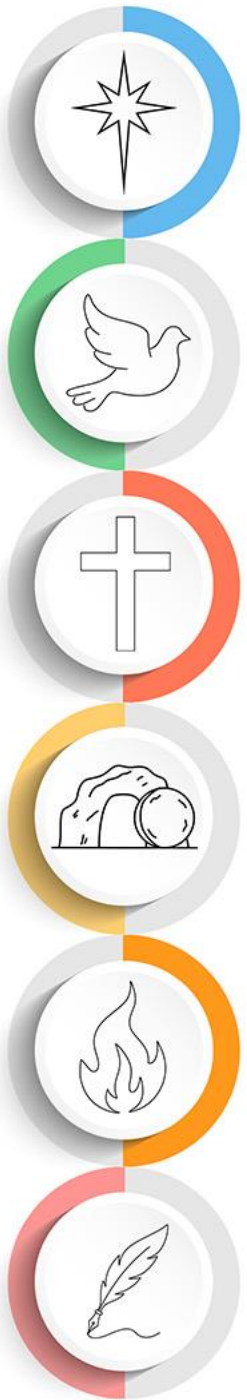
“They devoted themselves...”
